

### OVERVIEW

#### 1. Background & rationale

To improve cancer care across the globe, the EURECCA platform will produce high quality virtual classrooms aiming to teach healthcare professionals and patients about colorectal cancer care. Objective review of the scientific information is provided via a web-based platform with practical, easy to use messages. Easy access allows for frequent visits to a range of different topics to allow users to master the best currently available information. An expert panel, assembled by EURECCA, is responsible for updating the classrooms on a regular basis and is supported by the Education and Training Committee of the European Society of Surgical Oncology.

#### 2. Aim

To produce a 'free of cost', easily accessible, web-based eLearning platform with the latest peer-reviewed treatment strategies for healthcare professionals and colorectal cancer patients. The effect of the eLearning platform on changes to patient care will be evaluated using surveys
